

OBJECTIVE

To assist in the undergraduate studies of a student at the University or Regional College of their choice.

ELIGIBILITY

- 1. Those eligible are sons or daughters of KABA Members. Economic needs will be considered in the final decision.**
- 2. Preference will be given to Agriculture related majors, however, all majors are eligible.**
- 3. Preference will be given to incoming Freshmen, however, past winners and upperclassmen are eligible to apply.**

SCHOLARSHIPS

Two (2) scholarships of \$1,000 each will be presented to two (2) students residing in the state of Kentucky. Two (2) scholarships of \$1,000 each will be presented to two (2) students residing in Missouri. One (1) scholarship of \$1,000 will be presented to one (1) student residing in the state of Indiana.

Scholarships may be used at any accredited college or university within the Membership Area of Kentucky, Missouri and Indiana.

QUALIFICATIONS

In addition to the above listed requirements, the applicant should have a strong background in the activities associated with caring for beef or dairy cattle, exhibit characteristics of leadership, dedication and a strong interest in pursuing an ag-related career after graduation.

SELECTION COMMITTEE

Selection to be made by a committee consisting of:

- 1. 2 or more members of the Board of Directors from KABA/Select Sires.**
- 2. 1 staff member from KABA/Select Sires.**

In addition to the application, please include:

- 1. A written essay and biography sketch not to exceed 500 words describing yourself and why you would like to attend the university and major in your chosen field. A typed essay is preferred, not required.**
- 2. A copy of high school grades and ACT scores. (Copy of transcripts if already enrolled in college.)**
- 3. 2" by 3" head and shoulders photograph.**
